The 20-minute <u>Voyage to the Falls</u> boat tour, sailing from Niagara Falls, Canada, brings guests on a journey of a lifetime as they take in stunning views of the Niagara Gorge, American Falls, and Bridal Veil Falls, and come face-to-face with the famous Canadian Horseshoe Falls.
